Meeting Minutes April 17, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm by Commissioner Rob Hafitz followed by the flag salute.

Roll Call; Present were Fred Seitz, Jared Hafitz, Matt Wagner, Chief John Retalis.

The minutes from the previous meeting were unavailable and will be prepared for and filed before May's meeting.

Chiefs Report: Chief Retalis mentioned there was 111 calls for service in the month of March. Chief then spoke about the commissioners insurance and that it covers 5 commissioners however the individual names are unnecessary. The township was asked for \$350,000 advance to cover pension payment. The township agreed and advanced the money. Chief reported no major problems with the trucks. The new thermal imagers (2) came in were registered and put into service. Copier lease increased from \$200 a month to \$209 per month. A new lease is being signed. Robbinsville submitted their 30 day notice to discontinue the service agreement for fire investigations. May 11 would be the last day of the agreement. Chief to meet with fire marshal regarding this matter. Uniforms are being ordered together to make one large order as opposed to multiple smaller ones.

Fire Official Report: Two gentlemen from the Seton Hall fire are all set to run their program at the high schools. Steinert was set for April 19. The cost is to be split among the districts. Nottingham High School is scheduled for April 28, Trenton Catholic scheduled for May 11 and May 26 for Hamilton West.

Treasurer Report: None

Fire Company Report: Jason Belmont to attend manager course first week of May at a Cost of \$60.

New Business Bills and Resolutions: Shane Mull spoke about a contract addendum for Retirees to insure that any succeeding public employer fulfills the obligations of Hamilton Township fire district 7. Motion was made to pay the bills by Jared Hafitz and seconded by Matt Wagner. Motions passed

No further business was on the floor. Fred Seitz made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Jared Hafitz. Meeting was adjourned.
